# 4. Description of Projects

Title: Rhetoric of Cross-Culture in Graphic Art & Korean Piano Music

This creative project proposes an interdisciplinary collaborative performance that combines a digital media art presentation with a piano recital (by Okon Hwang) at Studio Theater in Eastern Campus. This project is highly influenced formally and conceptually by South Korean-born artist Nam June Paik(1932–2006). With his involvement in the Fluxus Art Movement, Paik played a pivotal role in bridging the gap between art and technology. Also as an artist he lived in Korea, Japan, Germany, and the United States, the time he spent living in these countries led him to question the distinction between borders and cultural differences. Based on my research of Paik's work, I will create original artwork that visualizes how American popular culture influenced Korean popular culture. As my first digital art presentation to Eastern students and Willimantic community, it will vastly benefit my teaching in digital art and design, creative research and services, and also provide a chance to network with faculties from other departments.
